

Audition Check List




- Choose an audition song*

CHARACTER GUIDE


If you want to play...	Look for monologues that are...
Edgar (Bat Boy)	Vulnerable, curious or "otherworldly."
Shelley	Rebellious, teenage angst, sarcastic, or romantic.
Dr. Parker	Intense, manipulative, authoritative, or
Meredith	Warm, protective, haunted, or maternal.
Ensemble	Character-driven, "big" personalities, or eccentric.

CHOOSING A MONOLOGUE




Choosing the piece

Look through the books and plays provided to find a piece. It is recommended that you choose a published play, but the internet also has useful resources.




45–60 second

TIP: Read your choices out loud and time them to make sure they fit the 45–60 second limit.



Ask yourself:

- *Can I clearly understand what my character wants?*
- *Does this fit the tone of the show or role I'm auditioning for?*
- *Can I perform the piece truthfully and confidently?*



HEADSHOT



How to Take the Photo

1. *Stand in front of the black curtain*
2. *Face the camera straight on*
 - *Shoulders visible*
 - *Head and upper chest in frame*
3. *Expression*
 - *Relaxed, confident, natural*
 - *Think: “pleasant and present,” not posed*
4. *Take several options*
5. *Don’t forget to take a QR code. I’ll upload the photos by the evening.*



RESUME

1. Open the resume template.

- Make a copy so you can edit it

2. Fill in the basics

3. Complete your experience

- Theatre (shows, roles, school/program)
- Training (classes, workshops)
- Special skills (be honest and creative!)

4. Check formatting

- One page only
- Clean and easy to read

5. Save your file



CHOOSING A SONG



Choosing the piece

Pick a song you like to sing and that feels right for the character. Since this is a rock musical, pop, rock and musical theatre songs are all encouraged.



16–32 bars

About 30–60 seconds



Preparing the cut:

- *A clear beginning and ending*
- *A strong emotional moment*
- *No long instrumental breaks*
- *Avoid stopping in the middle of a phrase or thought*
- *Clearly mark your music or cut the track where you want it to start and end*
